### The Position

SHS seeks a talented and highly qualified full-time Religious Studies teacher at the Preparatory. The candidate must be able to teach high school students in grades 9-12. Successful candidates must prove excellent skills as a teacher and a strong ability to collaborate with colleagues. Excellent candidates will demonstrate a passion for preparing curriculum and teaching teaches high school students any of the following topics: Introduction to Catholicism, Personal Morality, Hebrew/Christian Scriptures and Social Ethics. - Excellent verbal and written communication skills, as well as outstanding interpersonal skills.
- A broad knowledge of and experience with current best practices in curriculum and instruction, especially standards-based learning
- Demonstrated ability to teach scripture in a creative and charismatic style that provides a profound and sincere experience of Sacred Heart and Catholic principles and inspires adolescents to a deeper involvement in both.
- Demonstrated ability to integrate innovative technology to support student learning.
- Demonstrated ability to support all learners, including those with an identified learning difference and/or disability.
- Willingness to adapt to an existing curriculum as well as contribute ideas to enhance the respective academic and other school programs.
