First issue of *Religious* Education.

Became more interfaith and widely ecumenical. Began to include professionals.

Grew very active. Members formed smaller denominational groups.

1970's

Sister organization, **Association of Professors and** Researchers in Religious Education (APRRE), formed.

2003

**APRRE and REA join to form** REA:APPRRE.
